RULES AND REGULATIONS

REGISTRATION

A \$20 registration fee is required from each team. Teams can register at www.joinmade.org

TEAMS

Teams must be composed of no more than 4 people.

All team members must be present and have signed waivers before any building can begin. Waivers can be downloaded from our website or signed in-person on competition day.

SAFETY

Each team member must be wearing safety glasses and closed-tœ shœs during the building process.

This year, only hand tools will be allowed! Cordless tools, such as power drills or sanders, are not allowed for the competition. Each team will be responsible for bringing their own tools.

For a detailed list of tools and materials, please see the Supplies List.

MATERIALS

Each team must use the materials provided and cannot bring any extra materials to add to, or embellish, their designs. Finishing materials, such as stains, paints or veneers are not allowed.

MADE will provide materials for the competition. Materials will include pre-cut wood, and some less traditional material choices to be revealed on competition day. We will also provide each team with fasteners.

BAD WEATHER

The competition area is sheltered, but in case of bad weather, the event will be cancelled and deposits will be refunded.

SUPPLIES LIST

MANDATORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Safety glasses
- Closed-tœ shœs

Long hair should be tied back and headphones should not be used.

SUGGESTED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- CSA-approved steel tœ shœs
- Dust mask or respirator
- Work gloves
- Earplugs

OTHER HIGHLY RECOMMENDED ITEMS

- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Water

MATERIALS

M.A.D.E. will provide materials for the competition, including wood and fasteners. Each team will receive an identical allotment of fasteners which can be used or traded to suit.

ALLOWED TOOLS

Remember, only hand tools are allowed!

Your team may bring any of the following: hand saws, hammers, mallets, utility knives, clamps, files, chisels, hand planes, hand drills, bevels... anything that dœsn't require electrical power.

Don't forget measuring tape, rulers and pencils!

PROHIBITED TOOLS

Cordless power tools or anything requiring electrical power.

The following are also not allowed:

- Finishing materials (stain, paint, veneer)
- Circular saws or jigsaws
- Grinders
- Biscuit joiners
- Torches or other sources of fire
- Hand routers
- Power hand plane
- · Air guns and other tools using compressed air
- Light fixtures
